As part of the conditions of entry we ask that you read the guidelines below.

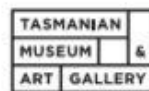
### **Liberty Postcard Exhibition Instructions and Guidelines**

1. Use the front of the postcard to draw, paint, write, collage, photograph or sculpt (any medium) to creatively express what Liberty means to you.
2. Use the back of the postcard to write a short description of what Liberty means to you, can be prose, poetry.....
3. Postcards will be showcased in a public exhibition at the Waterside Pavilion in April 2021.
4. There will be prizes for People’s Choice and Judge’s Choice categories.

2. Entry into the competition is deemed acceptance of these conditions of entry below.
3. The Liberty Postcard program commences on **Tuesday 29 September 2020 at 9.00 am (EST)** and concludes on **Friday 12 March 2021 at 5.00 pm (EST)**.
4. Two prizes will be awarded, which will be announced and collected at the end of the exhibition on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> April 2021.
5. All prizes must be taken as offered and no exchange is available. Prizes are not redeemable for cash and are not transferable to any other person.
6. The prize/s draw will be determined by our panel of judges and the winning entries will be announced on the Hobart Current website on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> April 2021.
7. The winner is required to provide proof of identity when they collect their prize.

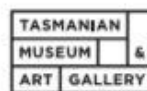
